

NAR REALTOR® Code of Ethics

As a new member of the Lakeland Association of REALTORS®, the Florida and National Association of REALTORS® you are required to complete a 2.5 hour training course on the REALTOR® Code of Ethics. This mandate from the National Association of REALTORS® must be completed within 30 days of your join date. This may be completed online at www.realtor.org. There after REALTORS® are required to complete quadrennial code of ethics trainings of 2.5 hours of instructional time. A REALTOR® completing the new member Code of Ethics orientation during any four (4) year cycle shall not be required to complete additional ethics training in respect of this requirement until a new four (4) year cycle commences. Failure to complete the required ethics training shall be considered a violation of a membership duty and cause for termination.

To complete online, follow the simple steps below.

1. Once online, visit: www.realtor.org
2. Click on the link at the top of the page that says “Register”
3. Follow the directions to register with the National Association of REALTORS®. You will be asked for your NRDS ID in this step.
4. Once registered, the National Database takes about 1 hour to update its records and will recognize you as a user there after.
5. Once your ID has been recognized, log in using the “LOGIN” link at the top of the page. Then click “Return to the last page you viewed”.
6. Close to the bottom of the page, you will notice a box “DO IT ONLINE” and following the instruction to complete the “New Member Code of Ethics Training”.
